



# Blackpool Steam and Vintage Vehicle Rally

To be held on Blackpool's South Car Park, off Yeadon Way, Blackpool, FY1 6BF  
4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> October 2014



## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY & SAFETY POLICY 2014 (FOR YOUR INFORMATION. PLEASE KEEP - DO NOT RETURN)**

- 1 This policy has been drawn up for the guidance of you, the exhibitor and with visitors to our rally in mind. It is our aim that you enjoy our event and we ask that you read, and comply with, this simple set of rules.
- 2 No exhibitor will be admitted to the rally field until 12 noon on Friday 3rd October 2014 for reasons of insurance.
- 3 The rally officials will be recognized by wearing high visibility waistcoats/jackets and will be happy to assist at all times.
- 4 At no time will the general public be allowed to enter the main ring, or any roped off area, without the prior permission of a rally official/safety officer.
- 5 Exhibitors must observe all and follow any instructions from their section controller, officials, and safety officer.
- 6 All entries received are subject to the discretion of the section controller prior to being accepted. A completed form does not necessitate acceptance. All exhibits must be over 30 years old or of special interest. No lawnmower type exhibit is eligible for entry.
- 7 ALL Steam vehicles MUST NOT EMPTY ash pans or ash onto the rally field, PLEASE USE A COVER AND BINS.
- 8 Once in place vehicles must not move without permission from the section controller. Test riding/driving is not permitted and there will be no joy riding in the rally fields at any time.
- 9 QUAD BIKES, SMALL SCOOTERS/MOTORBIKES & MINI TRACTORS ARE STRICTLY NOT PERMITTED TO BE USED AT ANYTIME FOR THE DURATION OF THE RALLY BY EXHIBITORS/TRADERS.
- 10 When reversing a vehicle take extreme care. All vehicles must observe the maximum statutory speed limit of 5mph at all times and give priority to emergency vehicles. Stewards must be present to marshall if vehicle has to be moved.
- 11 All moving machinery is dangerous. Young children are to be supervised at all times.
- 12 Working machinery is not to be left unattended, including stationary engines, oil drip trays must be used.
- 13 Loading and off loading of engines and mechanical equipment will be carried out as far as possible from members of the public. Such operations, will at all times, be conducted by a competent adult. Suitable transporters with adequate ramps will be used.
- 14 No person is to ride on any vehicle that does not have adequate seating. Tractors and motorcycles are restricted to one person only, unless a second seat is provided.
- 15 Petrol and other inflammable substances are to be stored in approved containers.
- 16 All generators MUST be earthed. This may be checked by HSE or local authority inspectors.
- 17 Electrical connections are only to be made in the approved manner. No leads to trail across, or be near public walkways.
- 18 I agree to produce, on request, an inspection certificate in accordance with IEE Regulations, for any electrical equipment (i.e. generators, wiring, appliances) I agree to abide by the Code of Practice of the Blackpool Steam and Vintage Vehicle Rally and the event's written statement of Safety Policy. I agree to operate my exhibit during the event and comply with the instructions of stewards. In the event of a dispute the event organiser/ Event Manager's decision is final.
- 19 Fire extinguishers are available – ask an official to provide you with one if necessary. Should a tent/marquee fire occur the public must move in an orderly way to a safe distance and must not impede the emergency services.
- 20 One caravan/tent will be permitted per exhibitor (limited spaces) and the organizers reserve the right to situate caravans in an adjoining field. DUE TO RESTRICTED SPACE NO GAZEBO'S WILL BE ALLOWED
- 21 In the caravan/camping area, the use of radios, cd players, generators etc will be forbidden after 10.30pm. Security personnel will strictly enforce this requirement.
- 22 Dogs must be kept on leads at all times. Please clean up after them and use bins provided.
- 23 The gates will be locked at midnight and opened at 6am for exhibitors ONLY, except for emergencies. (24hr Security will be on site to control access to and from site.)

CATERING: On site catering is available. BAR: The bar will be open from Friday evening. (Times to be confirmed)

### **Declaration**

**I declare** (a) that during the whole time that my exhibit is on the site of the Event it will be covered by Road Traffic Act Third Party Insurance if it is self-propelled, or (b) Public Liability Insurance with a minimum £2,000,000 limit of indemnity for any one incident if it is not a self propelled exhibit.

**I further declare** that where the vehicle is self-propelled it has been maintained in a roadworthy conditioned & that the driver will hold a driving licence of the appropriate class for the exhibit.

**I agree** to produce the insurance documents to the section Steward/Safety Officer on request.

**I agree** to operate my exhibit during the event in compliance with the Rally Organisers & Stewards instructions and in the event of a dispute accept the Organiser's decision as final.
